Before You [Start the application](#) you need:

- A Computer or Mobile with access to internet
 - On Mobile/Tablet the application might results more difficult
- Be able to edit images: sizing and cropping
- An access to a scanner or a mobile app that could scan
 - From the scanner app on mobile you will send the file to your email. From there you can download and edit. We suggest the editing before saving the scan file.
- A bank Statement in PDF of last month, preferably with darkened sensible data.
- Scan your travel ticket as a PDF: flight or cruise .

- Passport valid at least for the entire period visiting Brazil
- Online EVisa Application form completed
- Passport Style Photo (below are guidelines for it)
- Evisa Levy paid successfully
- Round trip tickets (flight, cruise or bus reservation showing the entrance and exit from Brazil)
- Bank Statement of last 30 days showing available at least USD 2,000.
- A letter from the cruise line confirming that the visa applicant has purchase a cruise ticket, or
- An individual proof of payment for a cruise Ticket.

Before You Start, Prepare the Documents:

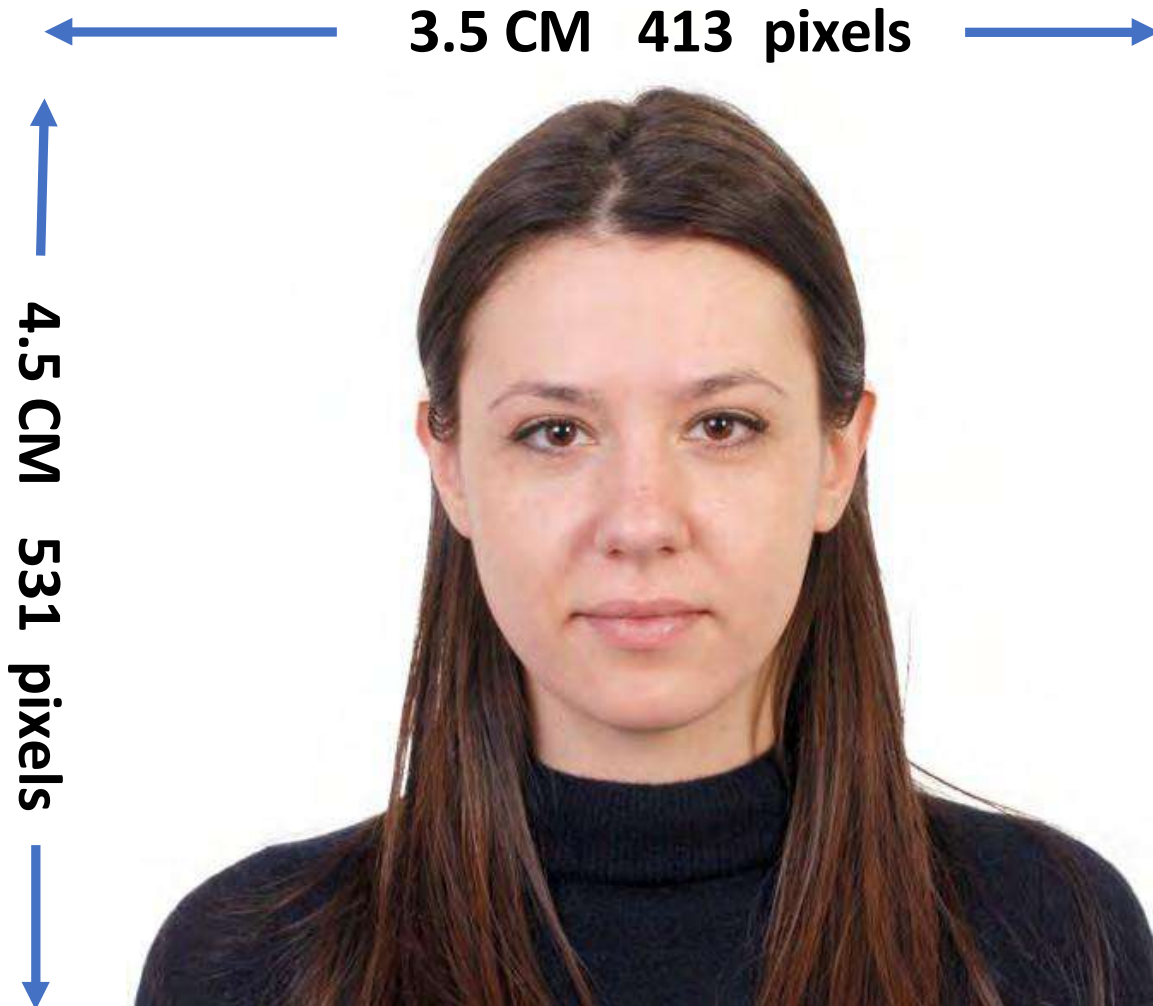
Gather the above documents before starting your application online. Please pay attention to the guidelines below about scan files and images quality.

The Brazilian immigration authorities are very precise and will ask to upload another scan/image if the one received doesn't abide to the general instructions.

BRAZIL PHOTO REQUIREMENT



- Color image Required (JPG or PNG < 1MB)
- Aligned with eyes at center
- Clearly focused
- Solid white backdrop without shadows
- Neutral facial expression, **no smiling with teeth**
- **Ears must be visible;** adjust with cotton balls if necessary
- Hair not covering forehead or ears
- Avoid wearing glasses
- Attire should be plain and dark-colored

Crop the photo after uploading, it's possible.
The size of the photo is less significant now.

How to scan your passport

- Only the page with your Bio info is needed. A convenient option is to visit a printing store and ask a scan copy of the bio page of your passport. The files can be sent to your email. It can be **PDF or JPG** and the **image must be in color** and should be crop. Maximum accepted size is below 1 MB.
- If you are familiar with any smart phone available scan app, you can also use your phone with apps to take and edit a passport photo easily.

Bank Statement Requirement

- Ensure your financial statement is in PDF format and less than 1 MB.
- Include your name and, if applicable, the names of joint account holders.
- Specify the financial institution's name.
- Clearly show the starting balance, ending balance (over \$2000 USD)
- The statement should have a closing date within the last 10 days; if not, supplement it with additional transaction statements.
- Aim for a comprehensive 30-day transaction statement for optimal results.

Cruise Operator Letter

- Certain cruise companies offer passengers a "declaration" confirming assets exceeding \$2000, which the Brazilian Government accepts instead of financial documents.
- Verify with your cruise operator's documentation department if this declaration is applicable in your case.

Travel Document Requirement

- Essential Travel Document Details
- Must display your name
- Includes a confirmed airline ticket, cruise boarding pass, or tour
- The itinerary should be an integral part of the document
- It's not acceptable to paste an itinerary from unrelated document

- Indicates the entry date and location in Brazil
- Indicates the departure date and location from Brazil
- For cruise travelers, include the full trip itinerary from start to finish, not just the Brazil portion
- Scan as a PDF file, not exceeding 1 MB in size, and ensure your name is visible on the first page.

Approval

Visa Delivery upon Issuance

The eVisa will be processed typically within 5 days.

If further info or document/scan re-submission is needed,
An email will advise the applicant to take action.

The traveler is going to receive his/her approved Evisa
for brazil via email.

DISCLAIMER:
The eVisa travel authorization system performs checks against Brazil law enforcement databases. National from Australia, Canada, Japan and USA seeking admission to Brazil are required to obtain an electronic visa using this system prior to entrance to Brazil. If your eVisa application is approved, it establishes that you are eligible to travel, but does not guarantee that you are entitled to enter Brazil. Upon arrival in Brazil, you will be inspected by a Brazilian Immigration Officer, who may determine that you are inadmissible for any reason under Brazilian law. All information provided by you or on your behalf, by a designated third party, must be true and accurate. An eVisa may be revoked at any time for any reason such as new information affecting eligibility. You may be subject to administrative or criminal penalties if you knowingly and willfully make a materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation.
